#### **Overview**

#### **School Board Overview:**

The Brotherhood of Excellence Academy Founding Board of Directors will establish a dedicated School Board to oversee the operations and management of the Brotherhood of Excellence Academy Charter School (Name subject to change). The School Board will consist of 5-9 members appointed by the Board of Directors of The Brotherhood of Excellence Academy.

#### **School Board Member Responsibilities:**

- Oversee management and operations of the charter school
- Develop and implement educational policies aligned with the school's mission
- Set academic and operational goals, and evaluate progress
- Ensure fiscal responsibility and transparency
- Resolve grievances from parents, teachers, and staff
- Amend the school's charter terms with approval from relevant authorities
- Collaborate with The Brotherhood of Excellence Academy's Board of Directors via the Executive Director

#### **Appointment and Term:**

- Members appointed by The Brotherhood of Excellence Academy Board based on qualifications and commitment
- 3-year terms, with the possibility of reappointment
- Terms commence in July following appointment/election

#### **Meetings:**

- Regular monthly meetings, with additional special/emergency meetings as needed
- Meetings open to the public, with designated time for public comments
- Quorum required for official business
- Closed sessions permitted for specific purposes outlined in state law
- Meetings conducted following Robert's Rules of Order



#### APPLICANTS SHOULD BE PREPARED TO:

- Review the Recording "How to start a Charter School" (1 hour webinar)
- Review organizational materials (Bylaws, etc.) -Available upon request by the Executive Director
- Complete the School Board Application, including the submission of a resume
- Attend 1 quarterly meeting with the founding board members for an interview of their appointment (Meetings scheduled: March, June, September, December Annually)
- Commit to a 2.5-3 year term and pre-scheduled monthly meetings
- Committee work (generally by email and telework)
- Consider making financial (cash/in-kind) contributions to the organization (optional but encouraged)
- Fundraiser-board participation needed
- Submit to a background check (Per Charter School Policy)
- Be able to attend monthly training by the Charter School Review Board (Ready to Open Planning Year)
- Be able to attend the Charter School Review Board Presentation regarding the School

**Donations:** As with any School Board members, we will be solicited for a cash or in-kind donation; 100% participation is sought; the amount is optional but we ask that school board members consider giving at a leadership level. School Board members should maintain an active membership status during their terms.

#### **Declaration of Candidacy**

School Board member positions require a time and energy commitment that should not be underestimated. Future School Board members are urged to consider personal priorities for the next year as well as the ways to contribute to the development of the charter school.
